1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded

Funds from Prop 28 are utilized to facilitate an all-school, full-immersion drama unit for which upper grade students write a script, upper and middle grade students design and create props, costume, and set pieces, and middle and upper grade students act as assistant director, stage managers, choreographers, sound designers, and props designers. The entire school travels to a local community theater where all students perform the play at no cost for all students in Humboldt, Trinity, and Del Norte counties to see. Staff provides technical support and supervision, transportation, and sound and light board operators.

Funds are also utilized to provide students opportunities to have local artists visit the school for presentations and specialized instruction. Funds are also used for art enrichment activities within the class and as all-school activities as well as a springtime enrichment program for which all students sign up for unique art and STEAM classes as electives.
